The Family Mediation Accreditation Portfolio Process

Following training, you will continue to develop your skills as a mediator. Your portfolio should reflect this. It is not expected to present a picture of a mediator a 'finished product' but of a mediator who has learnt throughout the process, and ultimately been able to demonstrate that they have met the required competencies, which are set out in the Family Mediation Council Standards Framework. Becoming familiar with the competencies will help give you an understanding of what you will have to demonstrate when you submit your portfolio.



Mediators do not have to follow a set pattern in terms of completing work for the portfolio, but should bear in mind that the order of events as set out in the Standards Framework is one that is designed to help them build their skills and knowledge incrementally.
