

COMPETENCE ASSESSORS REQUIRED TO JOIN THE PANEL OF ASSESSORS ON THE FAMILY MEDIATION COUNCIL

The FMSB is seeking to appoint competence assessors to the FMC panel.

The task will involve assessing portfolios submitted to the FMC as part of the accreditation process.

You will work with the existing panel of assessors to ensure common assessment standards are maintained. A period of induction will be given.

Appointment to the panel will be for a period of three years; assessors will be eligible for reappointment.

Assessors are paid £184 for assessing a first portfolio, and £105 for a resubmission. Assessors can expect to assess between 6 and 10 portfolios a year, depending on demand, though cannot be guaranteed any work and work flows are intermittent. Portfolios are allocated to assessors on a rota basis, except for any conflict of interest or assessor unavailability.

Assessors are also expected to attend two assessors' meetings per year, one online and one in London.

The successful candidate(s) will:

- Have held FMCA status for at least 5 years and be in current practice
- Have substantial recent experience acting as a PPC
- Have a good knowledge of the portfolio process, ideally having taken at least one consultee through the accreditation process
- Will have professional standing, and be able to demonstrate extensive participation in general professional activities i.e. training, committee work, management experience, publishing on professional topics
- Be able to work independently and within a structured timescale

Applications for appointment are invited in writing including a letter and CV detailing how you meet the above criteria and details of two referees.
